Re: Collecting KS3 assessment papers and using mark schemes

In December all pupils in Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 took an assessment in English, maths, science, geography, history and French. We reported the percentage achieved in each subject on the pupil report. The assessments reflect the knowledge and skills that pupils have learnt. The papers have been marked by your child's teacher and are now available for them to collect from Student Services between 8:30 and 15:00 on the following days:

Year 7 – Wednesday 24th February

Year 8 – Thursday 25th February

Year 9 – Friday 26th February

Pupils should arrive at the academy wearing their face mask and only enter school via Student Services.
