It is important that we support the government in reducing contact between groups of children and adults and wherever possible have the minimum number of children and staff in school during this period of partial closure. However, we also recognise our role in supporting the country to continue to function. The children of healthcare professionals, those identified as critical workers and vulnerable groups of children will need our support.

Please support our staff by only using these facilities if you are unable to make any other arrangements. For instance, you may be a critical worker but do not need to send your child into school with other children and staff, because you are able to make other arrangements e.g. your partner is able to work from home.
