All pupils must enter the building through student services where they will be met by a member of staff who will ensure they are wearing a mask, register them and direct them to the room they will work in.

Pupils will be directed to wash their hands and go straight to their year group area/bubble. Teachers will meet the pupils and take them to a classroom within the bubble.

Once the pupils are in classrooms, they must not leave to walk around the academy unsupervised. Teachers will create a seating plan for each room, so we can easily identify close contacts if there are any subsequent positive cases.

Pupils do not have to wear school uniform but must wear face masks in corridors. Unfortunately, we will not be able to provide food during the sessions as the kitchen will be closed. I would advise pupils to have breakfast before they come into the academy. Pupils can bring in their own refreshments to have at break time. Cleaning staff will be on site throughout the day to ensure rooms are sanitised regularly.

The sessions will help your child complete coursework in their options subjects and their teachers have planned the sessions carefully to ensure that all relevant topics are covered.
